They were protected at the higher starter event first off the claim and had adversity at the SLOG/TROUBLE_S and significant ground loss in the process three weeks ago.

He ran to that forward progression last month with a B/BTL effort where he was probably "best" on the day settled for place given the "trip" and won the GALLOP+ out.
