#1 I DON'T GET IT should move up on the class drop along. While they recorded some strong figures last sprint, their current form warrants the change in class to find the right level for their abilities. The switch to the dirt is the unknown for #7 PASS THE BATON though otherwise fits in this group and intent in the second start of the season. They wheel right back from showing run after a SLOG/TROUBLE_S making a WIDE MOVE X_FLOW and return to the preferred route distance here.

Woodbine Race 2

Value should hold on #7 COLONEL MUSTARD coming off a 6th place finish a B-/BTL effort last month. His form fits off that race as well as the events this season and surface versatile should that come into play.
