He showed raw ability breaking his maiden on debut with a BTL effort overcoming some adversity and recording a B+ OptixGRADE in the effort - a two turn initial start, a testament to class. He validated that effort pairing B+ efforts showing GRIT through adversity and improved his figure to suggest he could step up once again in that department with age and maturity. Hi Ira.
